MINUTES

MINUTES: The Minutes for the July meeting were accepted as a true record and signed by the Chairman.
Cllr D Hood proposed, and Vice-Chairman Wells seconded.

RESPONSIBLE PERSON for the duration of this meeting for fire regulations: Chairman Brown who pointed
out all fire exits and advised that the meeting point was by the church gate.

COMMUNITY COUNCIL ASSETS: Chairman has updated the assets register, the standing stones have
been added as has the AED.

PLANNING MATTERS: None

MATTERS ARISING:

AED Training – *The Clerk explained that Cariat Training would come to the hall and train members of the
public for about 1 ½ hours. It was agreed that the Clerk would find out the availability of the hall and then
arrange preferably a Wednesday evening at 7.30pm during September or October. The Clerk will contact
local groups, WI, Church, School and Village Hall Committee inviting them to take part.*

Post Office connection problems – *Cllr D Hood advised the Community Council that the Post Office is
having problems with connections to broadband signal, Cllr D Hood stated that people will not bother using
the Post Office if it does not function correctly and the consequence will be that it will close due to lack of
useage. Cllr Wells offered to contact Newbridge Post Office who are in charge of Clyro Post Office to see if
anything can be done to improve the situation.*

Two letters were read out detailing incidents of perceived dangerous driving on/around the bus stop in Clyro, a long discussion ensued and it was proposed by Chairman Brown and seconded by Cllr A Hood that Cllr D Hood and Cllr G Franks will form an advisory group to research what can be done to help minimise the problems of traffic speed and behaviour through the village.

Vice-Chair Wells brought to the Community Council’s attention that DIS/2018/0089 (poultry unit) has seen the removal of the bund, this could impact on the Bronydd side of the community. Cllr Bates asked if an explanation could be sought from Powys Planning, Vice-Chair Wells proposed sending a letter asking for more information on the changes to the original plans. Cllr D Hood seconded, and the Community Council voted in favour of sending a letter.
